## **Understanding "A" and "B" Requirements**

Not all divers in a given age group are ready to perform the "A" list of competitive dives. Consequently, there is a "B" list of dives to encourage novice divers to participate in a meet.

"A" requirements define the dive list for participants who are eligible to earn team points (5 points for 1st place, 3 points for 2nd, 1 point for 3rd). Participants who are unable to perform the "A" requirements may compete as "B" divers and perform the "B" requirements for their age group.

"B" divers do not earn points toward the team score, but they can earn ribbons. For the purpose of ribbons, "B" divers only compete against other "B" divers in their age group.

Coaches must indicate on the dive sheet whether a given diver is competing as an "A" diver or a "B" diver. Those working the scoring table must be sure to differentiate between "A" and "B" divers in order to properly award ribbons and team points.
